UNIFORM POLICY

1. Aim

- 1.1. The aim of a high standard in school uniform is to give the pupils a neat and tidy appearance and to foster an identity and pride in being part of St Mary’s School.
- 1.2. All pupils should be aware that they represent the school, its ethos and its image, when wearing the school uniform – both in and out of school
- 1.3. The Governing Body support the Department for Education’s views on the importance of school uniform:

A uniform can instill pride; support positive behaviour and discipline; encourage identity with, and support for, school ethos; ensure pupils of all races and backgrounds feel welcome; protect children from social pressures to dress in a particular way; and nurture cohesion between different groups of pupils. Above all, many schools believe that school uniform supports effective teaching and learning and engenders a positive, calm and respectful teaching and learning environment.

2. Uniform

- 2.1. Our uniform has been reviewed in line with statutory guidance from the Department for Education (DfE).
- 2.2. Whilst you are in our school uniform you are representing the school and your standard of dress and your behaviour should reflect this at all times, including your journey to and from school.
- 2.3. We request that all items of uniform are clearly marked with the pupil’s name.

2.6. JEWELLERY AND MAKE-UP - must **NOT** be worn in school. Watches may be worn.

2.7. PIERCINGS – one pair of gold or silver ear studs in the pupil's ear lobes only. No additional piercing's are allowed.

2.8. HAIR - Pupils' hair must be a natural colour. Extreme hairstyles are not permitted. Pupils with long hair will be expected to tie this back during practical activities for health & safety reasons.

2.9. MOBILE PHONES – must be turned off during school hours (we accept no responsibility for their loss) and kept in pupils' lockers. The use of mobile phones is not permitted during the school day.

3. PE Kit

- 3.2. PE kit ordered can be delivered to any Clubsport shop across the county free of charge or to your home address for a small delivery charge.
