The Final **Assignment** on **MathsWatch**, it should take **1 ½ hours** to complete, but does not have to be done in one go. It covers all of the topics we have covered in the second half of the summer term.

If you have now completed everything, including the Final assignment and returned the completed sheet below, then it is time for a well-earned break from maths!
