1. Multifunctional Living

Exploration of each individual Context

1. Multifunctional Living

Multifunctional – a product that has more than one function. E.g. a lamp that can also charge your mobile phone.

Living – Relating to our everyday lives. E.g. cooking, cleaning, lighting, exercise, work, study, etc.

Exploration of each individual Context

2. Teenage Lifestyle

Teenage – Someone who is between the ages of 13 and 19 years old.

Lifestyle – Relating to what people like, fashion, music, trends, social media, etc.

Exploration of each individual Context

3. Nature and the Environment

Nature – Anything that is natural and not man made, e.g. plants, animals, parklands, gardens, countryside, etc.

Environment – Relating to maintaining the ecology of our planet, e.g. promoting care and welfare of wild animals, improving the environment through minimising or tidying of waste and recycling, reducing or minimising carbon footprints.

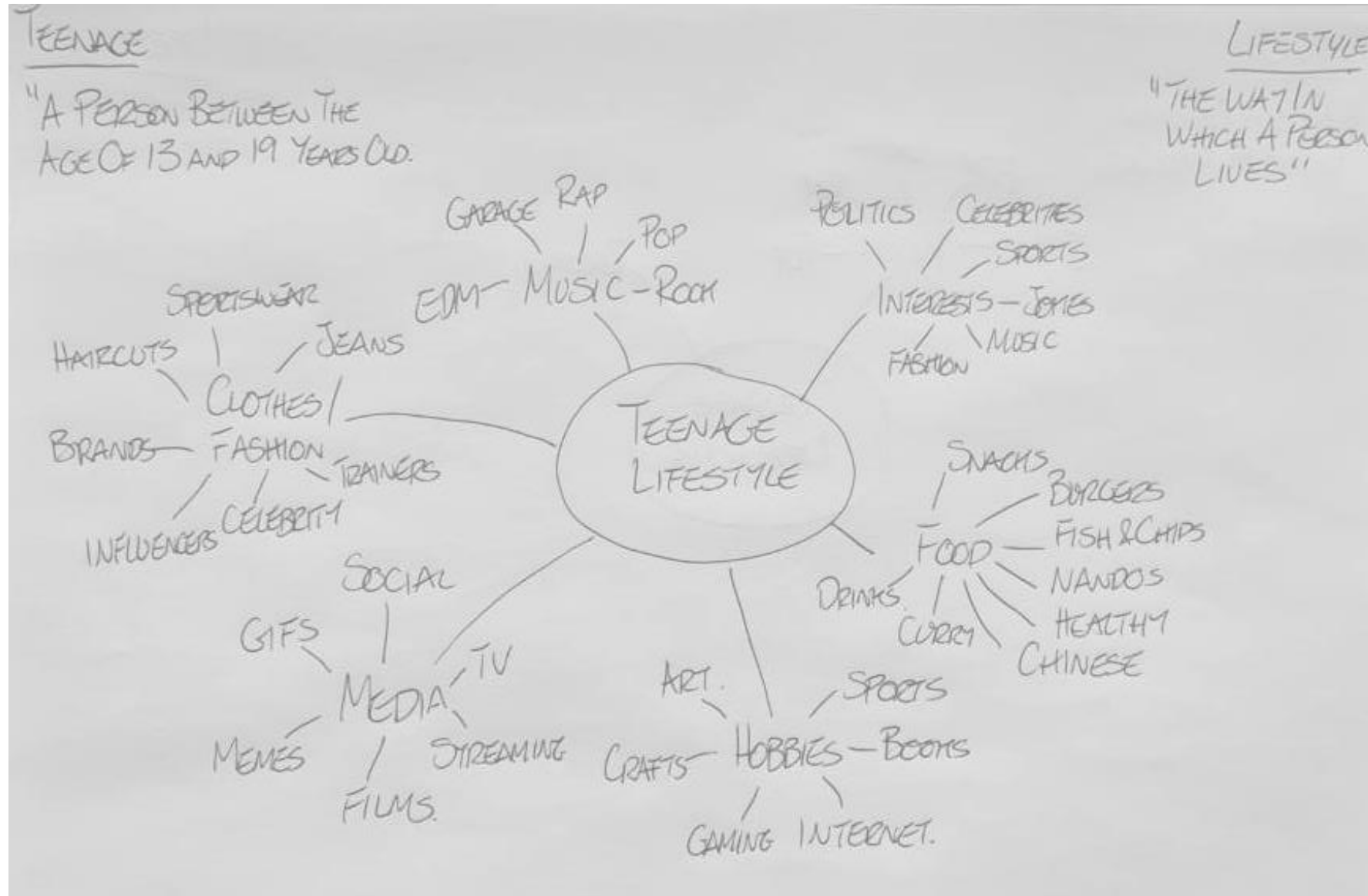
