

**YOU WILL NEED THE OUTLINE MAP OF EUROPE**

- 1 Find and colour in NORWAY, DENMARK and SWEDEN. These were viking homelands.
- 2 Now mark in the following: ENGLAND, ICELAND, RUSSIA, RIVER DNIÉPER, and also the major Viking cities of LONDON, DUBLIN, YORK, OSLO, KIEV, STOCKHOLM.

Add the cities of ROME and CONSTANTINOPLE.

**VOYAGES**

- 3 First draw an arrow by sea from NORWAY to ICELAND. Then draw an arrow by sea from SCANDINAVIA to BRITAIN. From BRITAIN draw an arrow by sea round SPAIN, into the MEDITERRANEAN SEA and to GREECE.
- 4 The SWEDISH VIKINGS took the EASTERN route. From SWEDEN draw an arrow across the sea and over-land to KIEV, then down the DNIÉPER RIVER to the BLACK SEA and through TO CONSTANTINOPLE.

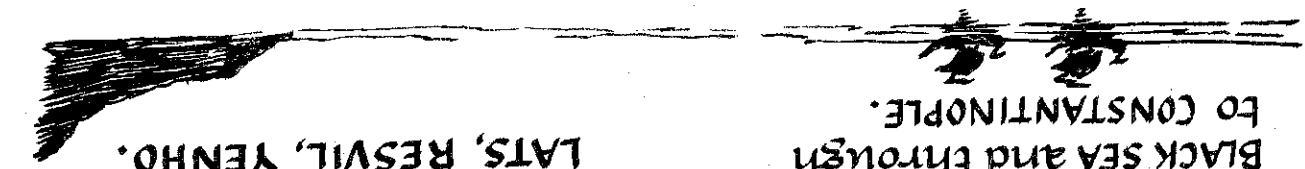


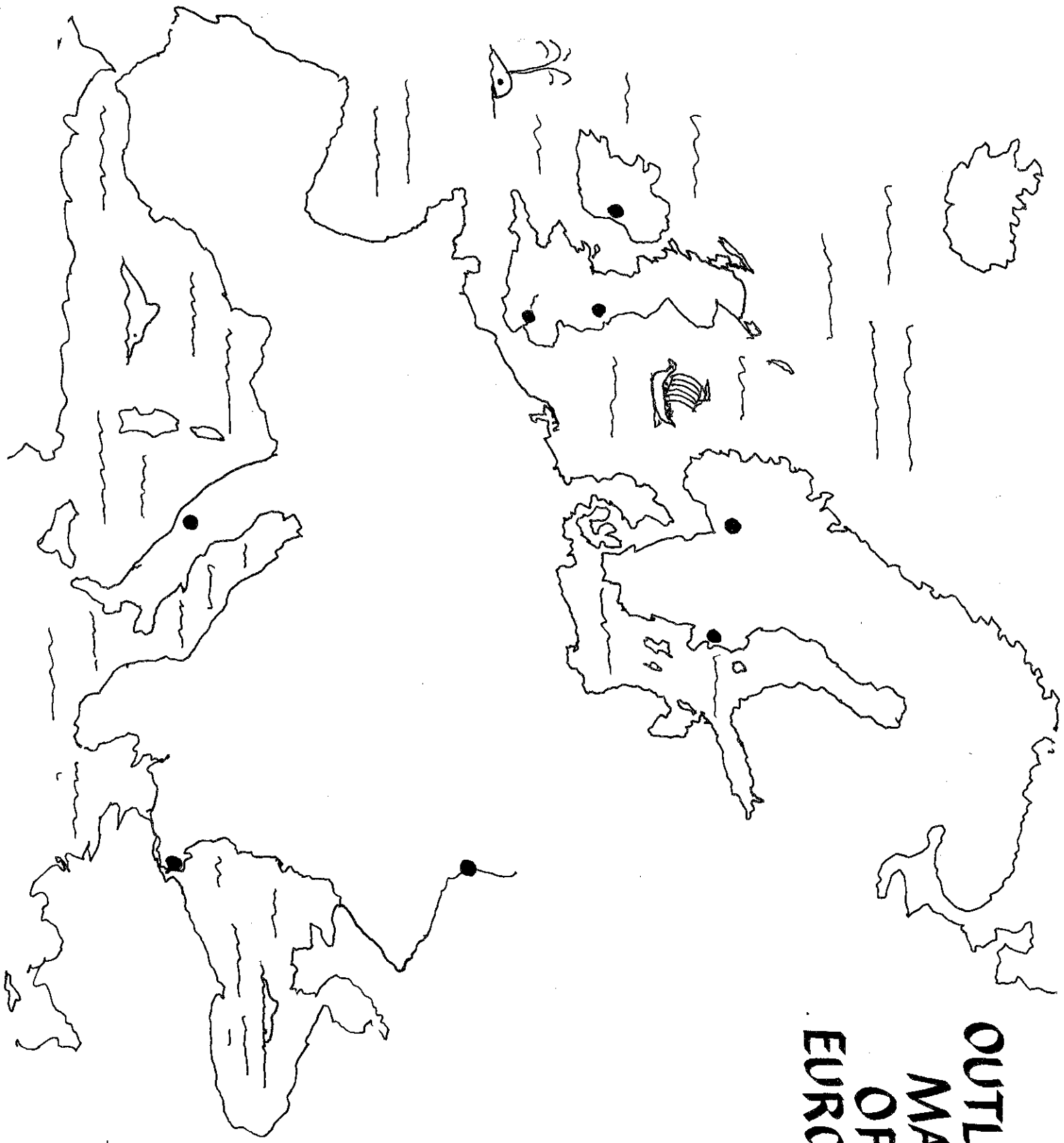
Study this list, which shows some of the goods and countries with which the Vikings traded.

WINE, SLAVES, POTTERY, GLASS, WEAPONS, CLOTH, JEWELS.
- BYZANTINE EMPIRE**  
SILK, FRUIT, WINE, JEWELS, SILVER, SPICES.
